# FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. Read Revelation 4:1-6a. What stands out to you about this description of heaven? What do you think stood out to John?
2. What does the throne signify? When in your life has remembering that God is on the throne been a comfort to you?
3. Read Revelation 4:6b-11. When you consider the worship going in this scene, what stands out to you? What questions do you have?
4. How can you prioritize worship in your life?
5. Read 5:1-7. What do you think the scroll signifies (see Daniel 8:26, 12:4, 12:9; Isaiah 29:11)? Why is the scroll so important to John in Revelation 5?
6. What about Jesus' description in Revelation 5 stands out to you? Why?
7. Compare the worship in 5:8-14 to the worship in 4:6b-11. How are they similar and different? What do we learn from comparing these two worship sections?
8. What is something you can do this week to sharpen your focus on Jesus?
