- 6. Read Matthew 26:31-35 and Luke 22:31-34. How did Jesus use this failure in Peter's life?
- 7. From John 21:15-17, what is the relationship between loving Jesus and serving Jesus?
- 8. Read John 21:18-19. How is this passage a call to all followers of Jesus? What is entailed by Jesus' command?
