- 7. How do see yourself involving yourself as a maturing disciple? What gifts do you have to encourage others to be maturing disciples?
- 8. Is it hard for you to submit to leadership sometimes? When is it ok to not submit to leaders? 1 Peter 5:5, Heb. 13:17
- 9. Discuss what it means to be "clothed in humility". The Word says: "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." What does this mean and how do we grow in humility? 1 Cor. 1:26-31, Phil. 2:1-11
