Who Are You?

• God is the $\underline{\mathsf{SELF}\text{-}\mathsf{EXISTENT}}$ Lord of all creation.

3:13-15

• God is <u>SOVEREIGNLY</u> active to bring about His purposes in this world and our lives. 3:16-22
