Who Am I?

- Our IDENTITY is found in God's Presence with us. 3:11-12

Who Are You?

- God is the SELF-EXISTENT Lord of all creation. 3:13-15

- God is SOVEREIGNLY active to bring about His purposes in this world and our lives. 3:16-22

FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. How has identity become fluid and malleable in contrast to how it used to be thought of? How does this create pressure and put burdens upon us?
2. Read Exodus 3:11-12. Where does this indicate our identity should be rooted? How can we grow in that? What are some New Testament passages that speak of this? (Galatians 2:20; Ephesians 1; Romans 6)
3. How do you understand the sign given to Moses in 3:12? How could this apply in our lives?
4. Read Exodus 3:13-15. What does God's name communicate about Himself? What about this was new for you? What about this is confusing for you?

6. How do we see God's name playing itself out in Exodus 3:16-22?
