4. Why do you think God chose the Father-child relationship as a picture of his relationship with His people? How does this encourage you? (see Hosea 11:1-9; Romans 8:16, 29; Galatians 3:26; John 1:12-13; 1 John 3:1)
5. How does Exodus 4:24-26 show us both the seriousness of sin and point towards how God deals with sin?
6. How do we see God going before Moses in Exodus 4:27-31?
7. What does it look like in your life right now to step out in obedient faith?
