- The trajectory of the Lord's judgment is impending doom.

# FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. What are some ways that the church is "Asleep in the Light?" How are we asleep to who God is and who He is calling us to be?
2. Read Exodus 9:14-16. What stands out to you about God's purpose here? How does this align with other passages (Matt 28:19-20; Joshua 4:23-24; 1 Sam 17:46; 1 Kings 8:41-44; 2 Kings 19:19)?
3. Why do you think God shows such concern for His own name and His own glory? (see Ezek 20:21-22; 1 Sam 12:22; 2 Kings 19:34; Isa 48:9-11)
4. How can you share with other generations like Exodus 10:1-2 speaks of?
5. What characteristics of pseudo-faith stand out to you? Where do you see them in this passage?
  - Minimizing sin.
  - Remorse without repentance.
  - Not surrendering, but bargaining.
  - Keeping God at a distance.
6. How do the plagues of Egypt compare to the plagues of Revelation? What should this wake you up to? (see Rev 8:12, 9:2-10, 11:19, 16:10-11, 16:21)
7. How does this passage awaken you to who God is, and what He calls us to?
