REMEMBER THIS DAY...!

Exodus 12:30-13:1-16

- 1. Remember WHO we SERVE as God's CHOSEN people.
 - God's deliverance demands our complete devotion.

- 2. Remember our IDENTITY, as God's chosen people...
 - ...not just who we are, but whose we are.

- 3. Remember this DAY and that GOD ALONE SAVES.
 - He is our only hope.



FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

- I. Do you remember the day of your salvation? What was going on in your life at that time? How did God work in your life to set you free? Take time to remember and share your testimony...
- 2. We are a forgetful people...discuss some things in your life that are distractions, things that become "mini-masters" over you (ref. "TMT Test") that might keep you from serving God "with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, with all your mind..." What should we do about it? (I John I:9)
- 3. What does Deuteronomy 10:12-17 look like for Christians in the world today? What does it look like, personally, in your life? How can we encourage one another to be faithful in this command?
- God's deliverance demands complete devotion in our lives, what habits or disciplines have you developed in your life to grow in holiness and devotion to the LORD? What does scripture say about these things?

 (I Corinthians 5:6-8, Hebrews 9:13-14, Romans 12:1-2, Psalm 1:1-2)
- 5. What parallels do you see from Exodus 12:43-49 and how we celebrate communion each month? What does communion mean to you...? Do you identify with communion personally? (Mathew 26:26-29, Luke 22:14-21)
- 6. How are we making the teaching and sharing of God's salvation story a priority in our lives, especially as parents and grandparents? (Exodus 13:8-9, 14,16)
