(w. 24:3-4, 7, 12)
- III. Covenant worship requires a life of SACRIFICE.  
(w. 24:4-8)
- IV. Covenant worship leads to GOD'S GLORY in our lives.  
(w. 24:15-18)

# FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. Do you remember the first time you ever went to church? Describe your church experience growing up. What was church like? Have you ever had a “mountain top” worship experience?
2. What did you see in Exodus 24 about worship that encourages you in worship? What challenges you? What is acceptable worship?
3. How do we show reverence to God as we gather for worship? Do you see obedience in the word, and sacrifice as expressions of worship? Discuss examples. (Psalm 22:23, Heb. 12:28-29, Ex. 31:18, 2 Tim. 3:16-17, Rom. 12:1)
4. Discuss the contrast of the “blood covenant” described in Exodus 24:4-8 and Hebrews 9:13-15. How does this encourage you in worship? (Ephes. 2:13, 1 Tim. 2:5)
5. The “glory of the LORD” was seen as “devouring fire” on Mt Sinai (Ex. 24:17) God's glory is seen in other references throughout the bible. How is the “glory of Lord” seen in our lives today? (Ezek. 43:1-6, Luke 2:9, John 1:14, 1 Cor. 15:40, Rom. 8:29-30)
6. Do our core values at Temecula Hills encourage you in worship? How? Which ones?
