- 4. Read Philippians 2:3-8. How is Jesus an example of how we are to treat one another? What are some concrete examples of how we can do this well?
- 5. Read Philippians 2:8. How have we domesticated the cross? How can we appreciate its significance anew?
- 6. How would you respond to someone who said that Philippians 2:9-11 means that everyone will ultimately be saved (see Isaiah 45:22-24)?
- 7. How does it help you to know that Jesus is exalted by God the Father?
- 8. What are you especially thankful for this Christmas?
