2. Read Exodus 14:13-14, 21-23. How did Israel depend on God for salvation? How is this a picture of our salvation? (see John 5:24, Isa 51:10)

4. How have you seen the idea of mediator throughout Exodus? How is this encouraging?
5. In the book of Exodus, how do we see Israel in "layered" bondage? How is our bondage layered? What's the difference between being objectively free and subjectively free? (see Romans 6:6-13)
6. What is the purpose of the Law given to Moses? (see Lev 11:45)
7. How does the idea that we have not arrived yet impact you personally? (see Phil 3:12) How do you think it should impact us as a church?
8. What is one truth from Exodus that has deeply impacted you as we've gone through the book?
