FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. Think about the situation of Israel on the shores before God parted the Red Sea. How is our situation similar to theirs? How is it different?
2. What are some things in Luke 9:28-36 that connect Jesus' story to the story of Exodus? How does Luke 9:51 help us understand how this impacted Jesus' ministry?
3. What in Jesus' arrest and crucifixion points us to the Exodus story? (see John 18:4-6, Luke 23:32-38)
4. How has Jesus' death in your place changed your life? How does it change how you live on a daily basis?
5. How is the picture of Jesus with two thieves on either side a picture of salvation (see Luke 23:39-47)?
6. Considering Jesus' resurrection, what evidence do you find the most compelling? What questions about Jesus' resurrection do you have?
7. Read Luke 24:1-6. How does Jesus' resurrection give *us* a victory? How do we share in Jesus' victory?
8. How is baptism a picture of Jesus' death and resurrection (see Romans 6:4, Titus 3:5-6, 1 Peter 3:21). How is your baptism an encouragement to you?
9. This Easter, how has Jesus' resurrection given your life new hope?
