- 3. Consider Hebrews 4:12 in light of Hebrews 3:7-9, 3:13, and 4:7. What does Hebrews 4:12 mean in this context?
- 4. Why is expositional preaching of God's Word so important to the health of a church? What happens when preaching loses its centrality to a church? (see 2 Tim 4:1-2; Tit 2:15; Acts 20:28-32; 1 Tim 4:13-16)
- 5. What does it look like for our lives to be Bible-saturated? (see Psa 1:1-3: Deut 6:6-9)
- 6. How have you seen anti-intellectualism in the church? In your experience, how is the mind developed or neglected through the church?
- 7. What does it look like to "Love the Lord your God... with all your mind" (Matt 22:37)? How do we sometimes separate our lives into the sacred and the secular? How important is how we think to our Christian lives? (see also Rom 12:2; Eph 4:22-24; 1 Pet 3:15)
- 8. Of our three theological values, which one stands out as important for you to focus on right now? Why?
