FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. What has been most encouraging to you during this series, “We are the Church”? What different perspective(s) do you have regarding the Purpose, Vision and Values of Temecula Hills?
2. Take a few moments, take turns, and read out loud our Purpose, Vision and Values under our Theological and Relational hills. Is there anything that strikes you for the first time tonight?
3. Now read the Missional Hills value about “Body-Life” and the associated scripture references. (1 Cor 12; Rom 12:4-8; Eph 4:7-16; 1 Pet 4:10-11)
4. Discuss the importance of spiritual gifts. What gift(s) do you have and how do you see God using you...don't worry, it's not boasting in yourself but boasting in the Spirit! If you are not sure how you are gifted, have others from the group tell you how they think you may be gifted spiritually.
5. How does the gospel inform every aspect of our lives? What area(s) of your life do you integrate the Gospel well, what areas could use some improvement? (Rom 12:1; Tit 2:2-10; 1 Cor 10:31; Col 3:17; Eph 5:18)
6. Read the Great Commission, Mat 28:19-20 and read Acts 1:8. How do you see the local churches role in this? The emphasis is on making disciples. How do we do this?
7. What can we do to encourage our supported missionaries? Consider downloading the Operation World app or the Voice of the Martyrs app and/or their prayer app “Pray Today” to be aware of what God is doing around the globe.
