- 1. In what ways are you tempting to preach an incomplete Gospel? Is it difficult to talk about God's wrath? How is wrath related to the Gospel? Romans 1:16-18
- 2. Read Job 12:7-8 and Psalm 19:1-6. How does Creation reveal God's eternal power and divine nature?
- 3. In what ways have you seen God's glory in Creation? Consider sharing pictures with your home group.
- 4. What does it mean to be "without excuse?" How does this apply to us? To the person that has never heard?
- 5. Romans 1:18, 21-22 describe the concepts of suppression of the truth of God, and becoming a fool while claiming to be wise. Who is this talking about? Does this apply to Christians? In what ways does the natural man suppress the truth or become foolish? If you believe that this also applies to Christians, how do they suppress the truth and/or become foolish? 1 Corinthians 1:18-25
- 6. What does God's wrath look like? Romans 1:24-32. Romans 2:5
- 7. Has your view of God's wrath changed at all this week?
