Romans 2:1-11

• We are **IMPERFECT** judges. (w. 1–5)

• Only God is the <u>PERFECT</u> judge. (vv. 6–41)

• Our only hope to be judged <u>FAVORABLY</u> is by faith in the <u>GOODNESS</u> of God. (v. 4)
