## **SOLA FIDE**

Romans 4:1-12

 Abraham was <u>JUSTIFIED</u> (declared <u>RIGHTEOUS</u>) by faith alone.

• Because justification is by faith alone, it is a free <u>GIFT</u> of sheer <u>GRACE</u>.

 Because justification is by faith alone, all peoples can be <u>UNTIED</u> through faith in Jesus.

- 3. Read Romans 3:27-4:3. Why was boasting such a big deal? How does that play itself out today? How does Abraham figure in?
- 4. Read Romans 4:4-8. How does his argument move from justification by faith to justification by grace?
- 5. What are some bad answers to the question "Suppose that you were to die tonight and stand before God, and he were to say to you, 'Why should I let you into my heaven?' What would you say?" What is are some good answers?
- 6. What are some ways that we subtly start putting confidence in our own works?
- 7. Based on Paul's argument in Romans 4:9-12, how does justification by faith alone create unity for all peoples?
