- 3. Read Romans 8:5-8. What is the relationship between the Spirit and our mindset? What are some things we can do to cultivate a Spirit-filled mindset? What are the most practical and useful things you've done in this regard?
- 4. What are some common misconceptions of the Holy Spirit? What does the Bible say in response to these misconceptions?
- 5. What is promised about the New Covenant (see Ezekiel 36:25-26; Jeremiah 31:33-34)?
- 6. Read Romans 8:9-11. How is the Spirit described as our source of life? How do you understand verse 11?
- 7. Have you ever known someone who demonstrated that they lived from a source of life that was not of this world? How did they do so?
- 8. In your life, how can you experience the Spirit being your source of life on a regular basis? What would this look like this week?
