FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

- 1. What comes to mind when you think of Jesus entering Jerusalem at the Triumphal Entry? What are the emotions that you feel?
- 2. How does the fulfillment of prophecy affect your view of Scripture? Of Jesus? Read Luke 19:28–29, 35 and compare to Zechariah 9:9 and Zechariah 14:4.
- Consider that the disciples that Jesus sent to retrieve the colt had the situation play out exactly as He said it would (v32). What does this reveal about God? Psalm 33:4, John 17:17, Numbers 23:19
- Read verses 35-38. What is the reaction of the disciples as Jesus approaches the city? Do they give Him glory? Do they reserve any glory for themselves? 2 Kings 9:13, Psalm 118:26
- 5. How important is it that Christ be given glory? Luke 19:40. In what ways do we rob God of the glory that is rightly His?
- How does it impact you to see Jesus weep over Jerusalem? Think about His actions in light of what He will be facing in the coming days.
- 7. Read verses 41-44. How has Jerusalem missed out on the peace of Christ? Is Jesus right to pronounce judgment on Jerusalem? Do you have peace with God through Christ?
