- 5. How can we encourage and support one another in using our spiritual gifts for the common good of the church? Heb. 10:23-25.
- 6. How do you see the body of Christ and the unity we share because of Him? 1 Cor. 12:12-13.
- Review the seven gifts mentioned in this passage and discuss what these are and how God uses them to build His church. 1 Peter 4:10-11, 1 Thess. 5:19-22, 1 Cor. 14:1-5, Matt. 7:15-20, 1 Cor. 14:26-33, Heb. 10:24-25, 2 Cor. 9:11-12, 1 Thess. 5:12-13, 1 Tim. 5:17, Matt. 6:3, 2 Cor. 9:6-8.
- 8. Discuss how you think you are gifted and share what giftedness you see in others in your group.
