- What does it mean to put on the 'armor of light' (see Romans 13:12) and how does it relate to our Christian walk and spiritual battles today? (1 Thessalonians 5:8-10, Ephesians 10:6-17)
- 5. How should the urgency of salvation being nearer, make us want to "Do Christian Things"? What obstacles hinder us from acting on this urgency?
- 6. What does it mean to put on Christ and how does it enable us to love one another? (Romans 13:14; Colossians 3:1-17) Where do you want to see this lived out more in your life?
