## We must prioritize <u>unity</u> within the church: "commUNITY"

• We promote unity and peace in the church when we...

...treat each other with <u>patience</u> and <u>grace</u>, because the Lord strengthens us all. vv 1-4

...do everything for the Lord because He died for us and now lives for us. vv 5-9

...remind ourselves that the Lord <u>alone</u> will judge us for our actions. vv. 10–12



## FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

- What do you think about the illustration of the driver on the mountain 1 road? Do you see yourself getting dangerously close to the edge? Or, do you see yourself clinging to safety with unnecessary rules and standards that may only produce frustration and hypocrisy?
- Discuss what Paul is talking about when he refers to a "weak" 2. believer? What is a "strong" believer. Read Rom. 15:1
- Read vv. 1-4. Paul is promoting unity and wants us to be patient with 3. our weaker brother/sister by not guarreling over opinions. This requires patience, how do you see this working out in the church today?
- What hot topics tempt you to judge your brother or sister? What is the 4 biblical approach to these areas of disagreement? Compare areas of conscience/conviction and sin how do we differentiate and how do we respond to sin in the Body?
- Read vv. 5-9. Paul is talking about religious observances here. How 5 might there be division or discord because of this? Give examples. What does Paul tell us about personal convictions about these observances? What does Paul point us to?
- Read vv. 10-12. How does this help you understand your own 6 responsibility and how does it give you comfort for your brothers and sisters?
