- 5. Read Ephesians 2:11-16. What are some of the images Paul uses for division and unity? How does this passage help us see the cross as central to resolving issues of division?
- 6. How is the issue of our identity relevant to discussions about race? How does Galatians 2:20, 3:28 and Revelation 7:9--10 inform this?
- 7. Read Matthew 5:14-16. What does it look like to let our light shine when it comes to racial issues? How can we do this well? How does the example of our Christian forefathers encourage us in this?
