Paul's Mission:

Where do you need to be intentional in bringing someone the good news?

Church Participation:

- Let us strive together in joy, through material giving and prayer.

Paul's Prayer:

- The Gospel of Peace comes from the God of Peace, through Jesus, the Prince of Peace.

FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. In what ways are you intentional about sharing the gospel in your daily life? How could you grow in being more intentional?
2. Do you view your material blessings as a way to participate in ministry? How do you think about giving in relation to the gospel?
3. How have you experienced "the fullness of the blessing of Christ" (Romans 15:13, Philippians 2:1-2) through unity and participation with other believers? How can we, as a group, continue to build this kind of encouraging, Christ-centered unity?
4. How can we, as a home group and individually, better support missionaries and ministries spreading the gospel?
5. Paul asks us to "strive together in prayer" (Romans 15:30). What keeps you from making prayer a priority? How can we encourage each other in prayer? (Romans 12:9-13, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, 2 Corinthians 1:11)
6. Where do you need more endurance, encouragement, or refreshment right now? How can we pray for one another?
