Genesis 1–2

Biblical Manhood: The glad assumption of primary SACRIFICIAL RESPONSIBILITY...

Biblical Womanhood: The glad <u>RELATIONAL</u> partnership alongside of and under the <u>HEADSHIP</u> of sacrificial men.

- In the church, men are to take primary responsibility for <u>TEACHING</u> and shepherding, and women serve in <u>ENDLESS</u> other ministries that do not assert <u>AUTHORITY</u> over men.

- 1. Given the way our culture views gender, do you find the biblical perspective easy or difficult to talk about? Do you feel embarrassed or emboldened by the Bible's teaching? Why?
- 2. Our culture struggles to define what a woman or a man is. What are some words you'd use to define a woman or a man biblically? What does it mean to be masculine and feminine? What Scriptures would you support this with?
- 3. Look over Genesis 2-3. Where do we see the headship of Adam? What does the tempter's strategy for temptation of humans tell us?
- 4. Read Ephesians 5:22-33. What is the unique call to husbands and the unique call to wives? How are each of these a struggle? What questions do you have about this? How does verse 32 encourage you?
- 5. Read Romans 16:1-7. What are arguments people use from this passage for women pastors? How would you respond?
- 6. Read 1 Timothy 2:11-15. How do we know that this passage is not merely cultural or situational? How would you explain this passage to an unbeliever? What roles do you think women are restricted from holding in the church? What roles do you have questions about?
- 7. What is the value of having men lead in the church and in the home? How is this a healthy thing?
