4. Read Obadiah 11. Now consider Moses' action in Exodus 32:9-14. What does it mean to "stand in the gap"? Ezekiel 22:30. Who in your life can you be interceding for?
5. What stands out to you in Obadiah 12-14? Pay special attention to pronouns, repetition, and descriptions of people
6. In what ways do you find yourself being haughty or prideful rather than humble? What does the Bible say about pride? Philippians 2:3, James 4:6,10, Luke 14:11
7. How has God's Word impacted your life this week? How can the group be praying for you?
