 The real miracle of Jonah is that God mercifully gives us SECOND CHANCES. 3:1-3

■ The real, true miracle of Jonah is that God mercifully <u>WARNS</u> sinners of coming JUDGMENT. 3:4

■ The real, true, actual miracle of Jonah is that God mercifully HUMBLES sinners towards REPENTANCE and faith. 3:5-9

 The real, true, actual, ultimate miracle of Jonah is that God shows <u>MERCY</u> and <u>COMPASSION</u> to repentant sinners. 3:10

- 1. If someone asked you, "What is the miracle of the book of Jonah?" how would you respond with one sentence?
- 2. Read Jonah 3:1-3 and Jonah 1:1-3. What is the author conveying by this parallel? How does the constancy of God's Word contrast to Jonah's reaction? What does this tell us about God and humans?
- 3. In your life, how have you seen God give you 2<sup>nd</sup> chances?
- 4. Read Jonah 3:4. Why do you think this message of judgment is so powerful? See Romans 1:16, 1 Cor 1:18, 1 Cor 1:23-24
- 5. In our culture, what does it look like to preach a message of judgment? Is this important? Is this something we should do? What are some ways we are tempted to avoid doing this? See Acts 10:34-43, Mark 8:38
- 6. Read Jonah 3:5-9. How is the repentance of Nineveh instructive to us? How do we know if repentance is genuine? How ought we to engage in corporate repentance? See Matthew 12:39-41, Mat 3:8, Acts 26:20, Eph 4:28
- 7. Read Jonah 3:10. Is God changing his mind here? Why or why not? How do we see the miracle of God's mercy in this verse?
