- 3. Reading through Zephaniah 3:9-20, how could this passage find fulfillment in Israel's restoration to the land after the exile? What in the passage is inadequately explained by this fulfillment?
- 4. Compare 3:11-13 to 3:1-4. Why is humility the virtue highlighted here? Why is humility important? How can we cultivate humility in our own lives?
- 5. Consider 3:14-17a. How can joy in God strengthen us? How can we find joy in God and our salvation when our hearts are heavy?
- 6. Read 3:17. How is this verse comforting to you with what's going on in your life right now?
- 7. In 3:18-20, how does God's strong declaration of his restoration of His people encourage you?
- 8. What about the distant shores is the thing that stands out to you the most? What do you need to keep in your mind's eye to have hope this week?
