1. What do you think of haggis? 😊
2. Read Luke 15:11-24. How does this parable compare to the book of Haggai?
3. Consider Psalm 2, and Haggai 2:6-7, 2:21-22. What should our response be to God's declaration of "shaking the earth"?
4. Zerubbabel as a type of Christ helps us understand Jesus' roles. How does knowing Jesus as the 'Son of the Promise' (Acts 13:22-23, Matthew 1:12-13, Luke 3:27), the 'Suffering Servant' (Isaiah 53), and the 'True Signet' (Haggai 2:23, Colossians 1:15-20) deepen our understanding of our mission as His followers?
5. Jesus remakes His chosen into who God wants us to be (2 Corinthians 5:17). How do we see the Gospel reflected in Haggai? Haggai 1:7,1:14, 2:4-5, 2:9, 2:17-19, 2:21-23
6. Within Haggai, we see a call to the past, which illuminates the present and points us to the future. How does that parallel our Christian walk with Jesus? 2 Corinthians 1:10, 3:18; Philippians 1:6, 3:12-14, 1 Peter 1:3-9
