# **MALACHI 3:6-12**

God RESTORES our FAITH as we learn to REST in Him.

We learn to REST in God, when we...

- 1. REMEMBER God's <u>UNCHANGING NATURE</u> and faithfulness (3:6)
- 2. EXAMINE our HEARTS REPENT and RETURN to Him (3:7)
- 3. SUBMIT to God's WORD (3:8-9)
- 4. TRUST God's PROMISES of blessing and PROTECTION (3:10-12)

# **FURTHER UP. FURTHER IN**

## Remember-

- 1. How is God being faithful in your life right now? (even in your struggles) Ps 136, Lam 3:22-23
- 2. When we REST in God, we build our faith. Identify/discuss your biggest challenge to resting in God when discouraged? What's your greatest encouragement? (i.e. Remember, Examine, Submit, Trust) Malachi 3:6-12
- 3. What encourages you most about God's unchanging nature (immutability)? (i.e. His unchanging perfections (holiness), purpose, promises) Malachi 3:6, James 1:17, Numbers 23:19-20, Ezekiel 24:14, 2 Tim 1:9
- 4. How do you understand God's immutability when at times it seems like He has "changed His mind"? (i.e. Exodus 32:7-14, 1 Sam 15:11)

#### Examine -

5. Is 1 John 1:9 a regular habit for you in your Chrisitan walk? Why or why not? Is this a promise you struggle with? Do you have accountability in your life that encourages you in your faith? (Proverbs 27:17, Hebrews 10:23-25)

### Submit-

- 6. Is the act of giving an important discipleship habit? Do you see this practice as an act of obedience? Why or why not?
- 7. What are some reasons the NT stresses the importance of giving? (Rom 6:23, Phil. 2:6-9, Mark 12:41-44, Luke 16:13, 1 Tim 6:10-11, Heb 13:5, Matthew 6:21, Acts 2:44-45, 1 John 3:17, Galatians 6:9-10, Romans 10:14-15, Acts 11:27-30, 2 Cor. 8-9)
- 8. What keeps us from giving more to God...?

9. What are some of your favorite promises of God that encourage you most in your faith? (2 Peter 1:3, John 5:24, 1 John 2:25, Romans 8:38-39, Rom 8:32)
