FURTHER UP FURTHER IN

1. Have you ever considered being “on mission” in your life? Living with purpose, and for a purpose? Have you ever discussed being a family on mission? What does that, or would that look like? (2 Cor. 5:17-20, Mt. 22:37-40, Ephes. 2:10)
2. What did you learn from the good Samaritan? How can you relate to this parable in your own life? (Lk. 10:25-37)

5. Discuss ways you and/or your family can be intentional and prioritize others in your life who need God's love and mercy right now. What are some things you're doing well? What are some things you need to change?
6. How can you serve and practice acts of kindness to others in your neighborhood, at school, or workplace? Who comes to mind? What are their names? (take time to pray for them).
7. Discuss ways your Home Group and Temecula Hills can be a family on mission to love others and lead people to JESUS in our community. Let's be known as a church family on mission and encourage one another to get moving and put these things into practice.
