## FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

- 1. Read Luke 2:41-45. Have you ever lost a child? What do you think Joseph and Mary were going through? How was this different from their regular home life?
- 2. How does Luke 2:40 and Luke 2:52 help us see the point of this story? How does it impact you to see that Jesus had to grow just as any other human had to grow?
- 3. What do you think it was like for Jesus to experience growth physically, intellectually, emotionally, and spiritually?
- 4. How would you explain the idea that Jesus is One Person with two natures (a human nature and a divine nature) to someone else? (see Phil 2:6-7; Mark 13:32; John 1:1, 14, 18; Luke 10:22; 1 John 1:1-3; Heb 5:7-8, 4:15)
- 5. Do you think you tend to focus more on the divinity of Jesus or the humanity of Jesus? How might this affect your relationship with Him?
- 6. Considering the three ways we see Jesus' growing self-awareness work itself out, which stands out to you? Why? How is Jesus an example to you?
- 7. Why do you think Jesus says that He "must" be in his Father's house in 2:49? How does Luke's usage of this word help us to see Jesus' point? (see Luke 4:43, 9:22, 13:33, 17:25, 22:37, 24:7, 24:26, 24:44)
- 8. How can you follow Jesus by submitting to God's plan for your life this week?
