## **LESSONS IN THE WILDERNESS!**

LUKE 4:1-13

Satan uses temptation in our lives to **challenge** our **allegiance** to the **LORDSHIP** of JESUS CHRIST.

- 1. JESUS is the **Son** of **God!** (4:3,9)
- 2. JESUS shows us how <u>victory</u> over <u>temptation</u> is <u>possible!</u>
  - 1. The **power** of the **Holy Spirit** (4:1)
  - 2. The **power** of God's **WORD** (4:3-4, 5-8, 9-12)
- 3. JESUS has absolute **authority** over **Satan!** (4:6-7)



## FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

- 1. What are some parallels of the temptation of JESUS in the wilderness (Lk. 4:1-13) to those experienced by Adam & Eve in the garden (Gen 3:1-6)? What are some differences?
- 2. Describe what the "wilderness" in your life looks like at times...?
- 3. What do we learn about the devil from the wilderness that we need to be on guard from? (Jn 8:44,1 Peter 5:8)
- 4. What are some subtle ways the enemy works in our lives to test our faith, and challenge our allegiance to JESUS? (1 Jn 2:16) Can temptation be a good thing? How? (James 1:12)
- 5. What are the lies that you hear whispered most often? What Scripture do you use to remind yourself of truth? (1 Jn 5:18, Romans 8:1, 2 Cor 5:17, others...)
- 6. How can we better equip ourselves to overcome temptation in our lives? (Ephes 6:10-18, 1 Cor. 10:11, 2 Cor. 10:5, 2 Timothy 3:16)
- 7. What role does the Holy Spirit have in overcoming temptation? (John 14:26, 15:26, Gal 5:16, 1 Thess. 4:7–8, Romans 8:9)
- 8. Are you in the battle currently? Which lesson in the wilderness encourages you most?
