- 2. How do you view trials in life? Do you see them as being ordained by God to deepen your faith? Why or why not? Job 2:9-10; Gen. 50:18-2; James 1:2-4
- 3. Discuss how trials in your life have shaped your understanding of Jesus? Do you view them as something to be merely endured or something to be learned from? Rom. 8:26-30, 11:33-36; Prov. 3:5-6
- 4. How does Jesus' authority over creation (wind and waves) influence your confidence in His care during life's chaos? Job 38:1-5; Matt. 3:9; Psalm 104:3; Col. 1:16-20.
- 5. Why do you think Jesus rebuked the disciples? Why was he asking "Where is your faith?" How does this challenge you to think of your faith in the midst of trials? Psalm 46:1-3, 32:10-11; Matt. 6:25-34; Phil. 4:4-7
- 6. How does knowing that Jesus is God help you see God more clearly in the midst of trials? Psalm 107:23-32; Acts 10:36; Heb. 1:2-3
- 7. Share what trials you may be experiencing now, encourage one another in Scripture and prayer? Gal. 6:2
