Luke 10:1-24

1. We obey the Lord Jesus by **PROCLAIMING** the gospel of the **KINGDOM** with **URGENCY** (vv 1-11)
2. It is **URGENT** and **IMPORTANT** to respond in faith to the **MESSAGE** of the **GOSPEL** (vv 12-16)
3. It is **IMPORTANT** to recognize where our **TRUE JOY** lies (vv 17-20)
4. Jesus is the **MERCY** of God, who brings **SALVATION** to all of His CHILDREN (vv 21-24)

FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. How would you feel if Jesus personally asked you to go and preach the Gospel to your children or parents? What about in your neighborhood door to door? What about in a local shopping center? In a neighboring town? In another country? At what stage do you feel uncomfortable with that calling?
2. Charles Spurgeon said that “Every Christian is either a missionary or an imposter.” What do you think that he means by that statement? Do you agree with him?
3. Why is it that towns like Chorazin, Bethsaida, and Capernaum will receive harsher judgment than Sodom, Tyre, or Sidon? Luke 12:47-48; John 3:19
4. Read Luke 10:16. How is this comforting in our evangelism? Reference also Luke 10:21; 1 Corinthians 2:2, 14
5. Read Luke 10:17-20. How does this challenge you? In what do you find the most joy in life? How can you realign those things to align with Jesus’ words in verse 20? Are there any struggles in your life that are difficult to overcome by reflecting on the joy of your salvation? Psalm 51:12, Luke 1:47, Romans 14:17
6. Read Luke 10:21-24. Consider the relationship between the Father and the Son. How do these verses help you to appreciate the Trinity? Matthew 28:18; 1 Corinthians 1:15-17; John 6:37-40; 10:14-15; 17:1-26;
7. What in your life do you need to move from the “Not Urgent and Not Important” box to the “Urgent and Important” box? How can you shift it into that box this week?
