2. What does the rich man's motivation reveal about his heart?
3. Jesus warns against "all kinds of covetousness". (Lk 12:15) What forms of greed might be subtle or socially acceptable today?
4. Are there areas in your life where you're tempted to find security in wealth or possessions?
5. What does this parable teach about stewardship of resources? How can you surrender your plans and possessions to God more fully? Is there something you're holding onto that God may be asking you to release?
6. How can practicing gratitude help guard your heart against greed? What are some practical ways you can live generously this week?
7. Is contentment a struggle in your life? Have you ever considered contentment to be a spiritual discipline? What is it that we need to learn if we're to be content? (Ps. 73:25, Philippians 4:11-13)
8. Why does Jesus call the man a "fool"? What did he fail to consider? (Lk 12:20-21)
9. What would it look like to be "rich toward God" in your current season of life?
