Luke 12:22-34

Key Takeaway: True security is not in wealth or worry, but only in God's priorities and His faithful provision. Reconsider your priorities, because what you treasure reveals where your heart truly trusts.

FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. Have you ever experienced a season where worry divided or dominated your thoughts? What helped you (or didn't help you) during that time? (Colossians 3:1-2; Philippians 4:6-7; 1 Peter 5:7)
2. In verses 24-26, Jesus points to ravens and lilies as examples of God's provision. Why do you think He chose such ordinary images? What do they teach us about God's care? (1 Corinthians 1:27-28; Acts 4:13; 2 Corinthians 4:7)
3. What is the significance of Jesus calling His followers a "little flock" (v. 32)? How does this image affect the way we view God's care for us? (John 10:7-15; Psalm 23:1-2; Hebrews 13:20-21)
4. Jesus tells us not to be anxious. How does the Gospel make this possible: Moving us from worry and self-reliance to worship and trust in Jesus as our Savior? (Romans 8:32; John 14:27; 2 Corinthians 5:21)
5. As a group, how can we encourage one another to seek God's kingdom first when worry starts to creep in?
