Takeaway Truth: Your salvation doesn't depend on your willpower: It rests entirely on God's will accomplished through Jesus. Where there's His will, there's The Way: Jesus himself, who was unstoppable in his mission to die and rise again so you could have eternal life.

1. Jesus' Mission could not be Stopped.
2. Jesus was Willing to die to accomplish His Mission.
3. The people were Unwilling to accept Jesus.
4. Jesus' Mission will be accomplished at Passover, when Jesus Dies for us.

FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. When have you experienced a situation that felt overwhelming or out of control — yet later saw that God's purposes were still unfolding?
(Reference Luke 13:32-33; Acts 17:3; Romans 8:28; Ephesians 1:11; Philippians 1:6)
2. Jesus refuses to let Herod's threat stop him. How does knowing that nothing can stop God's plan help you rest in His sovereignty and in your unshakable security in Christ?
(See John 10:27-29; Acts 2:22-24; Romans 8:38-39; Ephesians 1:11-14)
3. Jesus longed to gather Jerusalem like a mother hen gathers her chicks, yet they were unwilling. What does this image reveal about His heart for His people? (Luke 13:34)
4. These people were unwilling, but Jesus still calls us under His wings of care and protection. What does it look like in your life to rest in His covering?
5. Where do you sense Jesus calling you right now — to trust Him more deeply, to surrender an area of control, or to follow Him with greater willingness?
