

SINK OR SURRENDER

Luke 20:9-19

Salvation comes to everyone who **SURRENDERS** to the **AUTHORITY** of **CHRIST** in their lives – who is the **CORNERSTONE** of our faith.

What does a surrendered life look like...?

1. A surrendered life is **GENEROUS**. (vs 9)

2. A surrendered life **PRODUCES FRUIT** through **OBEDIENCE**. (vs 10)

3. A surrendered life is **MARKED** by **HUMILITY**. (vs 16-18)

5. How do we cultivate a lifestyle of humility (not just a moment)?
Philippians 2:5-11; Luke 18:9-14; 1 Peter 5:5-6; Micah 6:8
6. Which warning from God have you been tempted to ignore lately (through Scripture, counsel, conscience)? What would "slowing down and listening" look like this week?
7. Why is surrender to Christ's **authority** essential to salvation and not just knowledge about Christ?
Luke 6:46-49; John 14:15,21; James 2:17-20
