FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. Why is it important that Moses uses the personal name of God (shown as Yahweh, or YHWH, or LORD in your Bible) in verses 4-5? What does it mean that God has revealed Himself to us?
2. When Temecula Hills says that we are “God-centered,” what does that mean?
