6. In your life, what does it mean to be absorbed with intentional discipleship?
7. Read Mark 4:26–29. What is the point about God's Kingdom here? How can we be part of spreading the kingdom of God?
8. Read Psalm 96. How does this encourage you as you think about our future in God's kingdom?
9. What excites you as you think about the future of Temecula Hills?
