(vv. 5-11)
3. It's **Probable**: Unconvinced **People** -- around **us**.
(vv. 12-13)

FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. How does the idea of God breathing life into His Church help us understand what is happening at Pentecost?
2. Acts 2:11 says they were declaring “the mighty works of God.” What truths belong at the center of our Gospel message?
3. The message describes Acts 2:12-13 as “the intermission,” not failure. What changes when we remember that God, rather than us, is responsible for changing someone’s heart?
4. Who is an “unconvinced person” in your life right now? How might Acts 2 encourage you to continue loving, praying for, and speaking truth to that person without trying to control the response?
5. Our Spiritual reality is that we are indwelt, empowered, and able to make an impact. Which of those truths do you most need to remember when sharing Christ, and why?
